GUEST SERVICES:

Airport Greeter – The greeter is the very first impression the Wish Family receives from Give Kids The World. This volunteer greets the Wish Family at the security exit at Orlando International Airport, escorts them to the baggage area and assists with the rental car or shuttle service process. If you are interested in this volunteer position, your contact information will be forwarded to our Airport coordinators. The Coordinators will contact you to set up an initial shadow session. The Airport coordinators are responsible for scheduling all shifts there after. A small stipend is available to assist with gas & toll expenses.

This allows the families to receive the correct pictures on the photo disc at the end of their stay. Training is available on the job.

The Conductor ensures safety for the families and operates wheelchair lift as necessary. Duties include driving the shuttle, greeting families, assisting families with loading/unloading, operating wheelchair lift, cleaning shuttle bus and notifying Engineering staff of any maintenance issues.

Concierge - The concierge volunteer provides information, suggestions and tips for different theme parks such as: Walt Disney World Resort, Universal Orlando, Sea World, Busch Gardens, Wet & Wild etc. The concierge area also works to create an overall VIP experience for our Wish Families by assisting with printing boarding passes, personalized itineraries, making dining reservations and other requested services. If you know a lot about theme parks and are passionate about guest service, this is the job for you!

Gift Giver – The Gift Giving volunteers assemble and distribute a gift for each day. Volunteers also set up a gift bag for each villa welcoming a new arriving Wish Family. The Gift Giving volunteer uses a golf cart to drive to each villa to distribute gifts to each child staying at the Village. Volunteer will work with a team of volunteers to complete the task.

Amberville Train Station/Marc's Dino Putt – Amberville volunteers are responsible for greeting every family visiting Amberville Train Station, playing with kids, supervising and monitoring the play areas, logging maintenance issues and completing assigned tasks/projects for the Entertainment Department. Amberville volunteers provide train rides on the JJ Express operation and assist guests in the Dino Putt area as well. All maintenance issues need to be logged and reported to the Entertainment staff.

Volunteers may be asked to fill in other Entertainment venues (i.e. Castle, Carousel, Amberville, Julie's Safari Theatre or Marc's Dino Putt). This position requires positive interaction with all families.

Volunteers may be called for last-minute shifts or asked to fulfill a character role, while volunteering outside the Character Program. Mayor Clayton and Ms. Merry visit children in the Gingerbread House during breakfast and dinner and seven nights for Villa tuck-ins. Other Village characters come out to play on various days. Characters are requested for special events

on and off property. *Not interested in being in costume?* Be trained as a lead volunteer ("Bunny Buddy") and assist characters during their shifts!

Gingerbread House – The GBH volunteer is responsible for assisting with the serving of meals, running food, refilling drinks, bussing tables, and clean-up. This is a true team effort by all involved. Groups, from the Central Florida area, fulfill monthly dinner shifts and weekend shifts. Individuals volunteer for breakfast shifts Monday through Friday and as substitutes for groups whenever necessary.

Duties also include restocking food items and clean-up.
