



JJ's Express Train

WHAT: JJ's Express is Give Kids The World Village's wheelchair-accessible train which circles the Amberville pond and chugs through a jungle and cave. The train will be undergoing a complete renovation, transforming the attraction into an engaging, immersive Jurassic-themed experience.

WHEN: Work will begin on Monday, March 8, and is expected to be completed in 5-6 weeks.

DETAILS: The scope of work includes:

- Refurbished train cars, colors and graphics
- New story line and audio
- Paleontologist dig area and other new visuals
- Two new character voices added: The Conductor and The Paleontologist
- Audio will point out venues along the train path, including the boat pond, Dino Digs, Lori's Magical Flight, Kelly's Sunny Swing, cave paintings, and more
- The drive system, batteries and charging method will be overhauled, featuring hands-free charging
- Enhanced, more precise motor control leading to a smoother ride
