Area	Important Info
Volunteer Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Volunteers must be 18 yrs. or older to operate the Carousel, by law. Volunteers must be 16 yrs. or older to be the Gate Keeper
Family Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Guests must be 16 yrs. or older to be unaccompanied by parents. If the children are 15 and younger, children need to have parent/guardian with them at all times. Parents must remain at the Carousel, visible at all times while the children are riding. They must remain at the Carousel while their children are riding.
Responsibility of Operator	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Never leave the controls while the Carousel is in motion. Keep the key with you at all times. Do not leave it in the control panel when the Carousel is not in motion. Walk button – Starts the Carousel. Takes about three seconds to start. The Carousel will stop automatically when the ride is finished. Jog – Use this button if you need to move the Carousel forward just a little bit. Stop – This button works the same as the E-STOP button. Establish communication with the Gate Keeper before starting the Carousel.
Responsibility of Gate Keeper	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Keep gate closed at all times while the Carousel is in motion. Ensure that all children are buckled in.
Carousel Key	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Carousel Key is stored in the Pillow Room of the Castle of Miracles.
E-STOP buttons	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> E-STOP stands for Emergency Stop. There are two E-STOP buttons. The first is just a few steps inside the gate, located on the Castle wall. The second button is located by the control box. Both buttons must be pulled out for the Carousel to operate.
Safety Instructions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> All children must be seated at all times – no standing in the snail or turtle cars. All children must be in a seatbelt, have an adult standing with them, or be old enough to hold on to the Carousel pole safely. Younger children who do not fit in a seatbelt may ride on the rooster with an adult seated behind them. No one is allowed to jump on or off of the Carousel or move from animal to animal while the Carousel is moving.

Safety Instructions (cont.)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • People on the Carousel should not try to touch or grab things or people who are along the side (for example, no “high fives” from people standing along the side). • If there is any rough-housing or dangerous activity on the Carousel, the operator should press the E-STOP button. • Adults standing on the Carousel holding a child must be on the inside of the Carousel.
Wheelchair Accessible Locations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The turtle and the snail are both wheelchair accessible. • Remove the seat from the animal. Turn the animal sideways to the loading position. After the wheelchair is placed inside, make sure they apply the wheelchair brakes. Use the seat belt extender to clip the chair into the animal. Turn the animal back to the ride position.
Phone/Emergency #'s/Contact Entertainment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dial 9-911 for an emergency from the Carousel phone, located next to the controls. The Manager On Duty is alerted and will come over to assist. • Dial 0 for Village Operator/Guest Services when there is a need for staff assistance (ex. to call for Entertainment or Public Areas). • First Aid Kit is located next to the controls and telephone.
Family Interaction Tips	<p>Do's of Affection:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Patting children on the head, back or shoulder • Side hugs • Fist bumps and high fives • Sitting close • Holding hands while walking (young children) • Verbal praise or recognition
Inclement Weather	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Carousel does not operate if there is lightning in the area.
Cleaning Procedure for 2 nd shift	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please use provided antiseptic wipes to wipe down any and all surfaces. Wipe down all of the Carousel animals and poles. Make sure to wear gloves while using wipes.
